We know that many renters have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

If you or someone you know is a renter or a owner of a rental property, you may be eligible for New York State's Emergency Rental Assistance program. This includes funds for your past due rent AND your past due utility bill.

Eligible renters can receive multiple months of rental payments for past due rent. The rental payment will be made directly to the landlord.

Please help us spread the word and share this information with any, and all renters/landlords in your community. As a reminder, the eviction moratorium is scheduled to expire in January 2022. Apply for your assistance today!!
