

BILL NO. 21 OF 2019

A Local Law to amend *Russell Gardens Code* Chapter 56 entitled “Vending Machines.”

Section One: *Russell Gardens Code* §56-2.A entitled “Newspaper vending machines” is hereby amended as follows:

A. A. Permit required. No person shall erect, establish, maintain or otherwise place a newspaper vending machine, self-service, coin-operated or otherwise, within the village without first having obtained a permit therefor. A permit issued hereunder shall be effective for a period of one year from the date of issuance and may be renewed from year to year by the filing of a renewal application. No permit shall be issued unless the applicant shall have paid a permit fee ~~of \$50~~ or the annual renewal fee ~~of \$25 for a renewal.~~ as established in the Miscellaneous fee schedule adopted by resolution of the Board of Trustees.—All fees shall be paid at the time of filing the application. No permit shall be assignable.

The fee schedule may be amended from time to time by like resolution and shall be available in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section Two: If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court’s order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section Three: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
