Re: October Maintenance Report

- 1. General Village Maintenance:** The street sweeper has been going out almost on a daily basis. The hub bearing on the rear steer wheel on the sweeper went bad which caused the hub to be damaged. A new hub was ordered and replaced by us. The rear brakes on the Ford truck were inspected due to noise and we found the pads and rotors to be no good. Rear brake pads and rotors were ordered and replaced by us also. This was a time consuming repair due to having to remove the rear drive axles in order to replace the rotors. The annual backflow check devices received an annual inspection. Verizon came in for the last installation at 90 Clent Rd. Upon completion, we received the cameras and installed. All of the newly installed cameras were adjusted for optimum street views. I along with Deputy Mayor Chaleff were trained on the new system.
- 2. Street Lighting:** There were two outages this month. We noticed on our daily morning routine that the lights at 22 Carlton Rd. and 4 Melbourne Rd. were not working. Upon inspection, we found that the bulbs were bad, and the guys replaced the bulbs and tested. All are operating normally.
