1. **Street Lighting:** The new LED (panel style) street light fixture was installed at the corner of Tain and Melbourne. 2 new poles and vintage fitted led fixtures were installed at the corner of Merrivale & Melbourne (rotted and blown over by wind) and at the corner of Client & Wensley (rotted).
2. **Snowstorm:** The village had its first snowstorm of the season. Everyone did a wonderful job keeping the streets open. There were no mechanical break downs or setbacks during or after the storm.
3. **Equipment:** The crew performed in house maintenance on all equipment which included fluids and filters changed. The machines were all setup for winter and tested for proper performance. The front plow lift piston on the 1993 International truck was sent out to have the seals replaced due to leaking. Rubber edges were replaced on both large plows. The 1993 International truck was sent to CowBay Construction to have the rear sander control box replaced since it was unable to send a signal to the solenoids. The 2009 Ford had its sander installed, greased, adjusted, and tested prior to the snow event.
