Re: September Maintenance Report

- 1. General Village Maintenance: We have continued crack sealing the roads weather permitting. The traffic triangle at the Clent Rd. & Tain Dr. intersection was power washed. The three remaining utility boxes for the security camera project were delivered. They were then drilled and mounted to the poles and installed at there prospected locations. The electric was run and hooked up. The camera mounts were installed on the poles and Verizon was notified to come in and install the routers. We went to Hicks Nursery and purchased four boxwood bushes for the handicapped pathway on the side of village hall. We also planted a few hydrangea plants to fill in the bare spots. A hydrangea was also planted behind the west side of the Tain Dr. pillar replacing the one that was crushed when the pillar was knocked over. All bushes have been trimmed back from the signs at the entrances. The street sweeper has been going out more frequently since the leaves started to fall.
- **2. Street Lighting:** There was only one outage reported this month. We were notified that the lights on Linford Rd. were not working. The lights were inspected and it was found that the fuse was blown. We replaced the fuse and tested. All are operating normally.
