

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY REGARDING CHANGES TO THE ADMITTANCE POLICY.

In order to be more equitable across all households we will no longer have 3 classifications of pool admittance (household, extended family and guests). Effective Saturday, June 26th there will now be two group classifications, household and guests.

Household refers to all individuals who have been verified as permanent residents of the home.

Guests refers to everyone else that does not have permanent residence in the home.

Effective Saturday, June 26th, every household is entitled to a maximum of 4 guests at no cost.

What does this mean?

Previously, households that did not have extended family did not benefit from bringing someone to the pool at no cost, now they can. Those families that benefited from extended family continue to do so, but with a maximum of 4 at no cost.

As in the past, guests must be accompanied at all times by a member of the household.

Please remember, as we open up to include guests, as per Nassau County Board of Health, "non-vaccinated individuals must still properly social distance and wear a mask when socially distancing isn't possible." In other words, capacity is dependent on our ability for those homeowners and guests to safely social distance.

The Board reserves the right to make changes as we roll out this new admittance policy.

We thank you for your cooperation and hope this change in the admittance policy allows you the freedom to enjoy the pool facility with the special people in your lives.
