**1.General Village Maintenance:** The street light pole on the Merrivale Entrance was knocked down from a vehicle. The pole and fixture had to be replaced. There was a light outage between 9 & 11 Dodford (replaced bulb) and the village was notified that 2 lights were out on the Joyce Cohn Pathway. One of the lights was a bad bulb and the other had a bad ballast, that fixture was retrofitted to an LED bulb. All village owned sidewalks were inspected. The crew broke out formed and replaced 4 sidewalk flags by Vivian lane, 4 flags on the corner of Wensley and Melbourne, the curb was also repaired in that location, 1 flag on the Wensley and Merrivale entrances, and 2 flags on the Tain entrance. After the cement was cured, the forms were removed and topsoil and seed were put down. The crew has started to crack seal the roads with hot tar throughout the village.

**2.Village Equipment:** The small Stihl chainsaw was brought to Mineola Bicycle & Mower to be diagnosed for a running issue. It was found that the carburetor was bad and was replaced. We also replaced the rear wheels on the walk behind lawn mowers as they wore out. New Stihl equipment was also purchased to replace older equipment. The new equipment purchased was a weed whacker, backpack blower, extended reach hedge trimmer and a 14" bar chainsaw.
