**1.General Village Maintenance:** The second village sign restoration has been completed and installed at the Wensley and Northern entrance. All village lawns have been blown out and thatched to remove the dead grass, fertilizer and seed will be spread in the upcoming future. All the leaves and debris from the fall sweeping has been loaded out of the pool and brought to the dump. The drains at and around the tennis courts have been cleaned. The street sweeper was out of service for approximately 2 weeks as some parts and repairs were needed due to wear and tear and rusted out parts. Also, the front hopper lift piston was leaking hydraulic fluid due to a worn-out seal. All parts were ordered, and all repairs were done by the village crew.

**2.Street Lighting:** There was 2 street light poles replaced this month, one due to rot, and the other knocked over from an accident. The rotted pole was replaced at 300-304 Melbourne rd. The pole, fixture, and node were replaced at 10 Darley Road. The village has placed an order for more poles, fixtures and nodes.
