A LOCAL LAW to amend Russell Gardens Code Chapter 45 entitled "Streets and Sidewalks."

Section One. Russell Gardens Code Chapter 45 entitled "Streets and Sidewalks" Article 1 entitled "Excavations and Openings" subsection 45-2(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Any such application shall be in writing and shall describe with reasonable certainty the place where any such street or other public property is to be excavated, trenched or opened or dug up, the purpose to be accomplished thereby and the maximum area in feet of the surface of such street or public property to be affected. Any person or corporation which shall excavate, trench dig up or open any such street or public property pursuant to such permission shall, at his or its expense, restore such street to the condition in which it was at the time when it was excavated, trenched or opened in accordance with the specifications outlined subsection B-or dug up. All restoration of utility cuts or road openings on any village road or street shall include curb-to-curb resurfacing of the entire width of the street, measured from curb to curb, and a portion of the length of the street, extending three feet from both sides of the utility cut or road opening. The road resurfacing shall include the entire road surface to the stop lines of the nearest intersections on both sides of the patch.

Section Two. This local law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
