Re: June Maintenance Report

1. General Village Maintenance: The crew has been filling potholes throughout the village almost on a daily basis. A flat plate tamper was rented from ABC Tool Rental for maximum compaction. We have currently used 2.5 pallets of cold patch. We removed the stump grindings from a village tree that was removed from the side property at 10 Merrivale Road. The hole was filled with top soil and seeded. All of the entrances, village hall and Clent Road triangle were weeded and new mulch was added to the flower beds. A new sprinkler timer was installed at the entrance to Tain Drive due to its malfunction. A sprinkler head was replaced at the Clent Road triangle due to a cracked housing.

2. Security Cameras: We received five of the eight cabinets to be mounted onto the poles. The cabinets were drilled out for the installation brackets and a hole was drilled for an LED power indicator light. The cabinets were then installed onto the poles and electric was run from the base of the pole to the cabinet. The poles that were completed have been installed and electric was hooked up at Tain Drive, Wensley Drive, Dunster Road, Darley Road, and Melbourne Road. The Verizon technicians ran their wire to our cabinets and installed routers and modems at those five locations. We are currently waiting for the three remaining cabinets to be delivered to complete the installation.
