1. **Snowstorms:** There were multiples storms during the month of February. The crew did an excellent job keeping the roads open for the residents and emergency vehicles. I placed an order with Velvetop for calcium chloride to clear the sidewalks and with Atlantic Salt Inc. to de-ice the roads and replenish our stock.
2. **Equipment Maintenance:** One of the (John Deere) snowblowers had to be repaired multiple times during the snow events due to wear/aging and weakened metal. After discussions with the Mayor, it was decided to order a new snowblower attachment. We are currently waiting delivery. In addition, the 1993 International plow attachment hinge lock was replaced due to wear. We performed preventative maintenance on the Elgin street sweeper (oil, fuel, air filters). All trucks have been hosed off and neutro-washed.
3. **Streetlights:** We had four (4) street light outages this month. Three (3) of them were due to bad bulbs and one of them was a lose bulb.
