1. **Street Lighting:** There were two street light outages at 238 Clent Rd. and 10 Wensley Dr. Both fixtures were removed, repainted, and retrofitted to LED light bulbs. The pillars at the entrance of Tain Dr. were completed and the lights were reinstalled. Electric was run to both pillars and the low voltage landscape lighting timer was reinstalled and is now working properly.
2. **Equipment Maintenance:** Both the 1993 and 2003 International Trucks went to Syosset Truck Sales, Inc. for NYSI and preventative maintenance. The 1993 truck had some minor repairs that were needed to pass inspection. We replaced the front brake pads and rotors, front shocks, and two transmission cooler lines on the Ford f550 truck. We had the two front tires on the Ford truck replaced due to wear. We also replaced a hydraulic motor for the salt spreader on the 1993 International truck due to a leaking seal. All the smaller machines have or will have their fluids changed prior to the winter months. All the small engine summer equipment was prepped with sta-bil fuel stabilizer for winter storage.
3. **General Village Maintenance:** The street sweeper has been going out daily to keep the streets and catch basins clean of leaves. Anthony Manta took his CDL road test and passed. All employees now possess the required CDL license. The tennis courts were closed in late October. All the nets and dividers were removed and stored in the garage. We rented a tow behind air compressor from ABC Rentals and all sprinkler systems were blown out and winterized.
