- 1. Landscaping:** Planting and lighting have been completed at the three entrances. The brick pillar at the entrance at Tain was knocked over by a truck backing up. The police were notified, and a report was taken. The crew has been mowing the lawns, pulling weeds, and trimming the bushes as needed on a weekly basis. A large branch fell from a village tree at 15 Melbourne Rd. We cut and chipped the branch.
- 2. Street Maintenance:** The crew have been out filling most of the potholes throughout the village. We have been using cold patch and a gas power flat plate tamper to get the best compaction of the product.
- 3. Street Lighting:** We replaced one pole this month due to rot at 22 Tain Dr. The light fixture was removed and replaced with a fixture that we had previously taken down and retrofitted to LED. There was also one light outage reported across from 46 Tain Dr. (bulb was replaced).
- 4. Park Fence:** A second coat of paint was completed on the wood fence around the parks at Melbourne Rd.
- 5. Tennis Courts:** The tennis courts were being rolled twice a week at the beginning of the season. The courts are now being rolled once a week and broomed after completion. Top dressing has been added to spots as needed before rolling. The courts irrigation timer was replaced due to malfunctioning.
